## User's Reference Guide—Basic Reference Section

### Program Lines Containing "Wrap-Around" Line Numbers

Certain program lines, because of their length, may contain a line number that "wraps around" to the next screen line. If you list the program on the TI Thermal Printer or via the TI RS232 Interface, the "wrapped-around" line number may be replaced by random dot patterns.

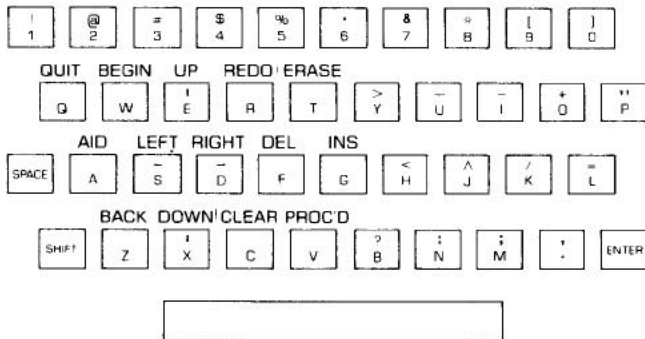

# Standard Keyboard Overlay Change

Minor modifications have been made to the keyboard overlay packed with your TI-99/4 Home Computer. The drawing on page 11 of the *User's Reference Guide* may therefore be incorrect.

The CMD key (SHIFT V) is now labelled PROC'D. The function of this key is explained in appropriate Command Module manuals. Also, the ENTER key is no longer labelled FWD on the overlay.
